Objectives:

- 1. You will be able to understand the difference between speaking to superiors and speaking to friends, as well as to talk about topics that are familiar and of personal interest using polite and honorific words.
- 2. You will be able to ask appropriate questions when you have words or contents that you do not understand in your daily life. You will be able to keep talking and not give up, even when you don't know what they're talking about.

Class Hours:

One hour a week (20 weeks in each semester)

Compare the Japanese culture with the cultures of various countries and learn practical Japanese so that you can respond to various situations in your daily life. In class, students will practice and perform in activities that will help them acquire Japanese language skills that you can actually use.
